Here are some of the "Headlines" from November and December:

- * Presently, I am discipling two men on Wednesday nights before the service. One is from Cameroon, Africa. He got saved and baptized in October and continues growing in the Lord. The other man is a USAF Captain. He works in the Medical squadron. He recently got assurance of his salvation and is now growing in the faith.
- * A man from the church and I went out to the Old American Village in Tachikawa to go soul winning. We went door to door sharing the good news of salvation. The "village" is made for Americans who work on the air base. Please pray for these folks to get saved as we continue to be faithful in our duty to be witnesses (Acts 1:8)!
- * I was talking with an Air Force MSgt and he informed me there were seven suicides in the last 11 months in Pacific Air Forces (PACAF; includes air bases in Japan, Korea, Alaska, Hawaii & Guam). This is unprecedented! We've endured three suicides here at the Yokota Air Base. PACAF sent a team of specialists in to Yokota to find out what is going on. I believe kicking God out of military life is not helping. They even took down the cross from the base chapel! Service members need the LORD JESUS CHRIST, the Hope of Glory!
- * We had our annual "Friend Day" on November 13 with Evangelist Richard Harper. Four men trusted Christ at the end of the morning service! Praise the Lord! Bro. Harper finished out the week with us as we held our Winter Revival. Many decisions were made and the hearts of the hearers were revived!
- * Christmas and New Year's seemed to fly by! The boys opened gifts via Skype with Nan and Paw Paw and Dee Dee (great grandmother) in VA. Phebe had a grand time. She is so charming! It's nice to have a little girl. We rang in the New Year with a Watchnight Service at YBC. Four of our men preached and we observed the Lord's Supper at midnight. What a great way to begin 2017!

Thank you once again for all of your care and support. We are thankful to be your missionaries to the US Military here in Tokyo. May God bless each of you! We love you.
