Dear Ministry friends,

For the last three weeks, the Lord has pressed 2 Chronicles 14,15, and 16 on my heart. I encourage you to read it again and am sure that you will be impressed like I have been by how important it is that we "seek the Lord". Asa decided himself to "seek the Lord with all of his heart". He then commanded all of Judah to seek the Lord with all that was in their heart.

Just as Asa did, we are trusting in the Lord our God. This year's mission trip we will be hosting a Pastor's conference, Ladies' conference, and helping with the FOM summer camp. We are also be taking medicines and having a medical clinic during the conferences and camp for all of our ministry personnel.

The theme of the Ladies' conference is "The Battle Plan for Prayer". The pastor's conference theme is "Seeking the Lord" from 2 Chronicles. We are anticipating around 100 ministry people in the conferences and between 150-200 campers for teen camp. Please pray for the Lord to bless and to work in the lives of those we minister to. I will also be preaching during camp as well as speaking in two of our churches on the Sundays we are there.

We would ask from you, our partners in ministry:

- Prayer, that Christ would be exalted and would draw all men to Himself
- that all who are without Christ would be genuinely saved
- that a powerful outpouring of Christ would bring revival to our meetings
- that every heart would leave the conferences with a broken heart for souls and a new heart to serve Jesus
- that you would continue faithful to this ministry so that the churches can continue to see people saved, lives changed, and more young people serving our Lord
- that as you are blessed of the Lord and led of Him, continue helping us to rebuild the ministry buildings. Each building is being fully restored to "new" with finished block walls, and steel roof systems of heavy gauge sheet metal. Once restored, these buildings will last for years to come with no threat of termite damage.

Last of all, we would ask for your financial support for our trip. Along with myself, Kim, and Andra; our 19-year-old son, Landon is also going with us. He and another teenage boy are going to be leading devotions and doing basketball clinics at camp. We are trusting the Lord to provide the \$4000 needed for these two weeks. Any financial help you can give will be greatly appreciated.

Thank you for partnering with us in this work. The Lord is accomplishing His work through your prayer and sacrificial giving. You are a vital part of what He is doing in the Philippines and we look forward to what He is going to do!
