## April 2017 - Prayer, Praise & Progress Report

Dear Brethren in Christ,

*„And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly -- therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.“ 2. We are seeing tears, rejoicing, repentance and salvation. Joachim, a middle aged man came to me recently asking for prayer for someone else and I asked him if he himself was saved. Shortly thereafter he prayed and asked Jesus to be his Lord and Savior. It is a great joy to see people in our town being set free from sin, shame, and bondage through the precious and powerful blood of Jesus Christ!

**Baptism:** The end of March we baptized two women and a man in the indoor swimming pool in town early on Sunday before the regular service. It was a great testimony as they rejoiced in this step of obedience and victory. I gave them new Bibles in the service as we prayed for them and cheered them on to live valiantly for our King! There are others both refugees and Germans who are wanting to be baptized at the next time we plan for at the pool or the nearby lake. It is amazing the resistance they face in submitting to baptism, but Lord gives overcoming grace!

**Testimony:** One of the ladies that was just baptized came to Germany from Afghanistan. Her husband had been an interpreter for the US Army and they fled as refugees. Before they left Afghanistan the woman had a dream and saw Jesus (common for Muslims now). While in Greece she came into contact with Christians and was saved. She landed in a small town near us and one of our ladies in church saw her on the road needing a ride. The Afghan woman asked our lady if she knew Jesus and then came to church with her. Her husband is not saved and please pray he would meet Jesus as his Redeemer soon!

**Ministry:** There is a need for a men's ministry in our church and our region. We are wanting to start that soon and looking for avenues to reach both believers and unbelievers. It is a blessing to see more of the men in our church getting their voice and standing up in their God-called destiny. Please pray with us in this great need!
