First of all, we would like to thank you for your faithfulness to support the ministry here in Japan. It is a joy to be your representatives here in Japan to reach the US military and their families.

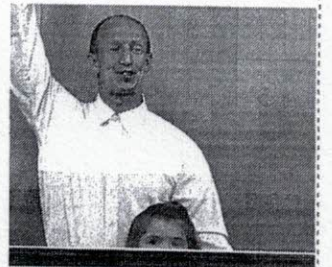
Allow me to share some of what the Lord is doing among us:
