Dear Brethren in Christ,

As we look unto Jesus and live in close communion with the Lord He changes us into His likeness. That is what I want for myself and for those whom I have the privilege of influencing. The Holy Spirit delivers the power to make that happen. That is good news for those who receive it!

Meetings - In April we had a Scottish preacher hold a weekend meeting on letting the Holy Spirit work changes in our lives. It was well-attended and received. The speaker spoke very direct with the people and to me at home as well. It is good to have people who will speak truth into your lives and I welcome that. As a side note we had the largest offering ever taken up in our church without hardly mentioning giving in the services. This month we just finished another meeting with a professional counselor that emphasized strengthening and deepening our relationship with Jesus. The stronger our foundation in God the further we can reach out to impact others for Christ!

Ministry - The end of May we baptized an Iranian couple that are refugees in Germany. They have converted from Islam and attend our church faithfully. They are not ashamed of Jesus and try to evangelize others. That sometimes makes it difficult in the refugee home as they receive kickback from the Muslims living in the house. Two German ladies in the church hold German language classes each week for this couple and another lady from Brazil. Our church is paying their legal fees as they are applying to stay in Germany despite the recent crackdown and removal of many refugees. The mission field is coming to us and we want to be faithful to reach them!

- The beginning of July I held a marriage ceremony for a young man who had been in our church years ago before he left with his mother. He called last year out of the blue and asked me to consider performing the ceremony. I met with him and his fiancée twice and agreed after they affirmed their faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior. The ceremony was held in the former Officer's club at the base I was stationed at as a young Lieutenant in 1979-80. I had freedom to share the Gospel and had positive responses from those who attended. Life is great and full of surprises and blessings!
