Hopefully in another month these restrictions will be lifted slowly.

For Christina, these last months have been very trying, but without her I do not know how we could have survived. She has had to take over many of the things I had been doing but have been unable to do since June. So, in many ways the lockdowns have helped in that we have been unable to do a lot of activities outside the home. God's plan is always perfect and we can trust in Him.

Certainly 2020 has been one of those years that most of us will never forget, even with the year still not finished and a possibility of new surprises still waiting us. The message I hear from the Bible is "the just shall live by faith." It is not a time to give up; It is a time to renew our trust and faith in God. It is not activity that accomplishes God's will; It is faith and trust in God. I had the opportunity to hear Pastor Lee Robertson preach many times when he was in his ninety's.
