God has done some amazing things here on Jeju Island. 1 Peter 2:9 says to "proclaim the excellent things He has done." Let me share a few.

- PTL, WOLBI Jeju has continued live classes without any COVID cases for almost two years.
- After COVID began, God provided one-year missionary visas for all our international students.
- PTL, live camps for high school students have continued. 15 trusted Christ this past month at day camps. We just accepted 130 campers for January 2022 camps.
- We recently signed partnership agreements (MOUs) with 4 like-minded Korean Christian schools to send campers and students our way. Six more MOUs in the works.
- Our students are currently serving in four local churches on the island.
- God provided amazing staff, mostly recent grads, who upgraded training and service to students.
- I preached thru the books of Daniel and Revelation. Next up ... Zechariah.
- God's hand has been with us thru my Dad's stroke, homegoing and care for both he and Mom here.
- This past month one of our recent grads began serving as a full-time missionary in Japan.

This year is the 12th year of WOLBI Jeju. We have definitely seen God's hand as we walk thru these unusual times. We continue to seek to reach the next generation thru evangelism, discipleship, and training new leaders. More and more they are stepping up and doing the things we used to do.

This year has been awesome but honestly it has also been one of our most difficult years financially due to COVID (students hesitant to enroll in a cross-cultural program during unsure times; freezing tuition rate to attract more students, facility upkeep that could not be put off any longer). Our monthly support has remained steady, but WOLBI Jeju comes to the end of 2021 needing **\$33,250** to finish in the black.

We have not been in this spot for a long time. We could really use your help. Above all please pray to the ultimate Source and Provider for us.
