Birthday celebration: One of our men celebrated his 60th birthday and asked to use the church facilities. It seems he knows everyone in town and a great crowd came out. He gave a testimony to those in attendance. We pray to reach the world and the world showed up at the door that evening. Even the auto mechanic who works on our cars was there. It was great talking with so many people!

BIMI Field Conference: Our missions agency holds a field conference in Europe every two years and this year we were able to attend the conference held in Switzerland, about a 7 hour drive from us. It was very encouraging and refreshing for us both. The great harvest is coming and we need to be ready. Amen!

Blessings of a family: Our son Tim, his wife Anni and their son Liam live in Germany about 90 minutes from us. They are expecting a daughter this May. Most of our grandchildren live in the States but we are so excited that we will have two grandchildren within easy range to spoil. We are so thankful for our family!
