Even Small Victories are Victories!

During the General Assembly, Senator William Stanley from District 20 introduced a "Harmful Materials" bill: SB1515. The bill overwhelmingly passed the Committee on the Judiciary on February 6, 2023, and was reported to the Senate where it was amended and passed with a 37 to 3 vote.

The bill then went on to the House where it unanimously passed the Courts of Justice Committee and eventually it unanimously passed the House.

After House amendments were agreed upon by the Senate, SB1515 went to the Governor's desk where he signed it into law on May 12, 2023. This bill will become law on July 1, 2023.

What this new law will do is require pornographic websites to verify the age of individuals before viewing the site. This law mandates that no one under the age of 18 may view the site in Virginia if more than one-third of the site contains material that is "harmful to juveniles".

I realize that this law still allows pornographic sites to be viewed in Virginia. I also realize that this law allows juveniles to access sites that have less than one third of its material that is deemed "harmful to juveniles." However, this law is a start. Any restriction is a victory. *Even small victories are victories*.
