On Easter Sunday, there was an overwhelming turnout, with only a handful of seats available, and a delightful lunch served afterward.

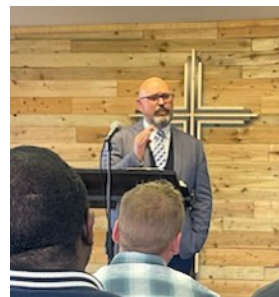
It is gratifying to witness the growth of the church, and the love and care demonstrated towards visitors are genuinely heartwarming.
