In any case that is living in this part of the world.

If you have never ventured this way before I encourage you to visit the southwest. It has a beauty all its' own. Some people like it and others do not. It was an entirely different scenery and way of life for us coming from Virginia some forty years ago. A lot of things have changed over the years but some things have pretty much remained the same.

The main roads have improved, but when you get off the main road it is like a third world country. It is sad to see the Navajo Nation not step up and make more improvements on the reservation for their people. But like our government, much corruption and mismanagement of funds have robbed the people of much needed help on their behalf.

It is our hearts desire to continue ministering to the Navajo people; hopefully until the Lord's return or until He takes us home. We ask that you pray with us.
