To make a long story short, Isla has some liver issues. We understand what her liver is doing, but we are still unsure why. However, she has improved enough to be discharged. Please continue to pray for Isla and for us as we work to determine the root cause of her condition.

It is a blessing to see them learning to share their faith.

We are also in the final stages of expanding our rented church property, which will allow us to seat an additional 20-25 people comfortably. Please pray for the completion of this construction project and for the Lord to guide us as we search for a permanent property to purchase.
