Prayer, Praise & Progress Report - April 2025

Dear Ones in Christ,

"For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish -- foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God." 1 Corinthians 1:18. I believe that we are in the end times before Jesus comes back. I tell our people there is a spirit of deception and seduction active in Europe as well as the world. We must not adapt our message or buy into new ways of thinking to please or conform. Only people saved through the blood of Jesus and born again by the Holy Ghost will be in heaven. The only thing we will take with us to heaven are those whom we have led to Christ. Amen!

Focus: Teach all nations (Matthew 28:19): We are training three men to be the future pastors of the church. Several other men are involved in the preaching ministry as well. Our desire is that this work would continue and stay sound in doctrine and practice. As a joint project we have developed a church doctrinal and values booklet for all that would become members. We have also written six flyers that cover six Bible topics, including salvation, baptism, discipleship, and what an independent free (non state) church is. These are being used for the small group meetings as a discipleship tool. Individuals are meeting regular with others for discipleship. We purpose to teach (gr. mathēteúō to make disciples) all nations!

Funeral: Two weeks ago a farmer called and informed me his wife just died and he asked if I would conduct the funeral. I had baptized his wife and granddaughter 5 years ago. The next day we met with him, his daughter and granddaughter, prayed, sang songs and planned the funeral. He, as a believer, wanted a victory celebration on the graveside. It was a small country town and about a third of the town was there at the funeral. I shared the gospel and then led in a sinner's prayer that was printed out on the program. Many began praying out loud with me. As I stood looking out at the crowd of people I thanked God that I was here for such a time as this!

Found alive: On Easter Sunday I preached with many visitors in attendance on "the Cross and the Lamb". The two disciples on the Emmaus Road found Jesus alive and ran back to Jerusalem with the good news. One day we as His saints will worship the Lamb forever (Rev.5:13). We are praying many would experience the resurrected life of Christ this year. He is risen indeed!

Future: Our church building is the former train station of our town. It still belongs to the German Railway and they want to sell it. The price they are asking is well above its value and we have been looking at other possibilities. Please pray with us as we need a larger facility for the growing youth ministry as well.
