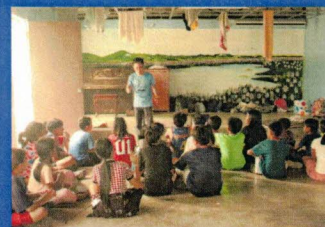
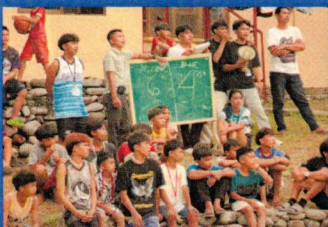
SUMMER CAMP 2025
