Dear Pastor and Church,

I thank the Lord for His traveling mercies during my recent trip to the U.S. Though I was only able to stay for two months, it was a blessing to visit several supporting churches, especially those connected to my late father's ministry. I apologize to those I wasn't able to see due to my limited time, but I remain deeply grateful for your faithful partnership and prayers.

We are now **stepping into another exciting chapter of ministry — planting our third church.** This third mission work will be in the island of Mindoro, in a village called Villa Cerveza, about 1½ hours from my father's home church. At the same time, **we are expanding our Bible school ministry.** By God's grace, we now have 54 students enrolled, and we are praying and preparing to build a dedicated facility that will house our students and also serve as a camp and retreat site. The land for this project has already been purchased through the insurance left by my father when he passed away.

In 2022, I've pioneered the second mission work in Laguna Province, (an hour drive south of Manila) It is now being led by my former assistant minister.



Now, we are getting ready to plant this **third mission work** (as I have mentioned in the first page of this report). We are currently clearing the access road and **preparing for Phase 1 of construction**. This new facility will be able to accommodate our **Bible students** and serve as a venue for camps and retreats.



Please pray with us for the Lord's provision. Each nipa hut (able to accommodate 8 people) costs \$2,500, and our goal is to build four huts along with a concrete chapel \$10,000 that will serve as both a place of worship and the heart of this new mission work. This has been the dream of my father when he was alive, and we gladly carry on the mission works he left behind.



Soon, you will hear about the progress of this project. We are still earnestly praying for some more budget. We prayerfully invite you to partner with us in this vision — to expand and strengthen our Bible school and to plant another church on the island of Mindoro — for His glory and the advancement of the
