## 1ST Quarter MISSION REPORT 2026

### MISSION UPDATES

\*New Village Church being planted.

\*Ongoing construction of Camp Site, Bible School.

\*8 believers were baptized

We are excited to report that our **newest mission work** is now underway. We have begun building relationships with the local residents. This new mission work is located on an island, called Villa Cerveza, with a population of about 3,000 people, approximately 1½ hours' drive from my father's church. This is now the 3rd church I'll be planting since I became a missionary. By God's grace, we were able to purchase a piece of land through the insurance my father left when God called him home.

At this moment, we have already accomplished the following:

- Constructed a perimeter fence using concrete posts
- Begun clearing and cleaning the land
- Started the construction of a nipa hut, which will serve as a resting place for Bible students and workers (expected to be completed in four days)

We praise God for these milestones.



We carry on the mission work our father left behind. We strive to bring the gospel in our city, on our island, and even to the tribal people. We go forth in grace alone.



Meanwhile, back in our mission work in Manila, we praise God for the **salvation and obedience of eight new believers who were baptized last month**. They have been faithfully discipled, and each one is now actively serving in a ministry. What a joy to see lives transformed and grounded in service to the Lord.

We also recently celebrated the **Mission Anniversary in Manila, the capital city** of the Philippines. A total of **224 people gathered to worship** the Lord with us. We continue to see new visitors coming to our church—not only individuals, but entire families. Please pray with us that we will see even more fruit and a greater harvest of souls in 2026.



I planted this church 15 years ago. From twelve people, it grew through the years by God's grace. From this congregation, we were able to plant another church in the next province called Laguna. Then, this year, we are planting another church, this time on a different island.

Finally, please continue to pray for us as we continue to prepare our new mission work for ministry. We are praying for the provision to dig a well or drill for flowing water and to install electricity. We sincerely thank the two churches who already went the extra mile to help us reach this stage (from page 1). We are still praying that more churches will commit to this project as we seek to build a small kitchen, a bathroom, and a chapel that will serve as our place of worship. The Lord has been faithful, and we will continue to trust Him for His provision. Thank you, Church. I miss you all. May we all have a fruitful 2026. Let us keep serving the Lord—He is still saving precious souls.
