3rd Quarter MISSION REPORT 2026

Dear Pastor & Church,

We are grateful to share with you some of the highlights in the mission field that God has allowed us to do for the past quarter. (1) Praise God! On **May 30**, we held our first evangelistic service at our newest mission. This is the place I've mentioned in my previous reports where we were building the chapel and ministry facilities. More than 250 people attended, including tribal children, local residents, and Christians from neighboring communities.

While we gathered the local adult residents inside the chapel, the tribal kids had their good news class under the tent. It was a simultaneous time of sharing of the gospel.



The gospel was preached, and I also had the privilege of personally sharing Christ with several local residents and construction workers. We praise the Lord that this ministry is already making an impact in the community. As we move forward, we are continuing to build relationships within the community. I am also working closely with a tribal pastor– a graduate of our bible school– who is helping oversee the ministry while I continue assisting our other mission works. We believe that the harvest is just beginning.



(2) We also thank the Lord for the **52 students who were enrolled in our Bible school** this past semester. About half attended online from diff. parts of our country, while the rest completed their studies on-site. Many are already serving faithfully in their local churches. Our desire remains the same: **to bring them in, build them up, and send them out.** (3) Finally, we rejoice that a man I led to Christ 11 years ago, who later completed our Bible school, is now leading a growing mission work in Bassano del Grappa, Italy, after moving there with his family last year. Lord willing, I will be ordaining Preacher Levi Baguinon and will officially commission this mission in the near future.
